Key Achievements from 2024-2025

- 🏆 Continued development of the Real PE Scheme with clear links between PE, PSHE and ACE Particles
- 🏆 Sports' Day - Feedback from staff, pupils and parents continues to be very positive
- 🏆 Continuation of a good range of extra-curricular activities including after school clubs
- 🏆 Sports Premium funding allowed equal access for all children to wider extra-curricular opportunities.
- 🏆 Membership of the School Games Programme and IPSSA (Boys and Girl's Football Small Schools League and Cup)
- 🏆 Expansion of our lunchtime sports clubs to include a daily option for Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 pupils.
